The new season marks the 10th anniversary of the SFJAZZ Center and the 40th anniversary of the organization. To celebrate, SFJAZZ will be presenting over 400 concerts from artists and musicians that have inspired and guided the organization for four decades. The events will take place at the SFJAZZ Center's Robert N. Miner Auditorium and Joe Henderson Lab, Grace Cathedral, Herbst Theatre, and Paramount Theatre in Oakland. Founded in 1983 by Randall Kline, SFJAZZ 's original goal was simple: to produce a two-day festival that featured Bay Area musicians representing the full scope of music that jazz encompasses. Thirty years later, the SFJAZZ Center opened on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day in 2013, and has become an award-winning performing arts venue and an integral gathering place for artists and audiences from around the world.

SFJAZZ will celebrate the Center's 10th Birthday with exclusive concerts from January 12-15, 2023 featuring many of the artists who were on hand for the Grand Opening Concert in 2013. The concerts feature tributes to two now-passed jazz legends who performed on opening night and a reunion of many of the SFJAZZ Resident Artistic Directors from over the last decade.
