FUNDRAISING

- ▶ **\$64 million** capital campaign to build SFJAZZ Center and grow endowment (100% raised to date)
- ▶ Membership up **149%** to 10,200 households since 2012

SFJAZZ CENTER

- ▶ First stand-alone building designed for jazz in the United States
- ▶ **LEED Gold-Certified**
- ▶ Grand Opening on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, **January 21, 2013**
- ▶ **35,000 square feet**: three stories of performance, education, and administrative space
- ▶ Located in the heart of San Francisco's **world-class Performing Arts District** and vibrant **Hayes Valley** neighborhood
- ▶ Within walking distance to **public transportation** (BART, MUNI); bike and pedestrian friendly
- ▶ 700-seat **Robert N. Miner auditorium** with flexible seating, state-of-the-art sound and lighting
- ▶ 100-seat **Joe Henderson Lab**, a state-of-the-art rehearsal, concert and performance space to support education programs
- ▶ **Digital lab and practice rooms**
- ▶ One gigabyte of internet connectivity, wifi-enabled
- ▶ **South at SFJAZZ**: bistro/bar under the leadership of **Charles Phan** of The Slanted Door Group, winner of 2014 James Beard Award
- ▶ **Artwork**: Three murals and a painting from artists **Sandow Birk & Elyse Pignolet**; Photography by **Jim Goldberg** and poetry by **Ishmael Reed**

- ▶ **SFJAZZ Collective** (*est. 2004*): award-winning octet annually commissioned to record and perform compositions by modern jazz masters and new pieces by its members.

- ▶ The multiple award-winning **SFJAZZ High School All-Stars** (*est. 2001*) attract the most talented young players in jazz through a rigorous audition process.
- ▶ **Monday Night Band** (*est. 2013*): is a hip, community band comprised of a wide cross-section of people from around the Bay Area.

SFJAZZ PROGRAMS & TICKET SALES

- ▶ More than **300+** concerts and educational programs are held each season featuring some of the biggest names in music alongside talented local musicians.
- ▶ SFJAZZ has **four resident artistic directors** who provide a diversity of creative voices: Zakir Hussain, Eric Harland, Terence Blanchard and Esperanza Spalding.
- ▶ **More than 88% of shows have sold out** since January 1, 2014.
- ▶ Tickets and revenue from **ticket sales have more than doubled** in the new SFJAZZ Center
- ▶ SFJAZZ Education **serves thousands of adults, youth, and families** through a plethora of workshops, classes, concerts, and programs
- ▶ SFJAZZ brings world-class artists out of the concert hall and into the community to serve kids in **San Francisco Public Schools** through its Jazz in the Middle and Jazz in Session programs
